## From Easter Day to Trinity Sunday

Readings from **The Acts of the Apostles** are used throughout the Easter season, but the various lectionaries use different selections of readings, and where they use the same readings, they are often on different dates. This lectionary has accounts from the early days in Jerusalem in Year A, highlights the emerging inclusion of the Gentiles in Year B, and follows the ministry of Saint Paul in Year C – including the Antioch reading not used elsewhere, in honour of Saint Margaret of Antioch, patron of Hornby. The selections used in other lectionaries are not detailed here Sunday by Sunday, but a code unique to this section cross-references each reading to the other lectionaries, eg RC E5C means 'This reading is used in the RC lectionary on Easter 5 in Year C'. CE provides OT readings for use in place of readings from Acts when required or preferred (eg for Evensong), but these are not listed here.
